THE COURT HEREBY FINDS that in instances where a claim has been filed against the City and County of San Francisco alleging injury, property damage or loss related to the Family and Children's Services Division of the Human Services Agency (HSA) that HSA has a compelling need to respond to the Claims Division of the San Francisco City Attorney's Office which is responsible for investigating claims filed against the City.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that HSA employees may respond to City Attorney Claims Division for the express purpose of providing information about claims filed against the City to enable the City to accept or to deny the claim. This may include providing information about child welfare cases.

This sharing of information specifically does NOT include the City Attorney litigation team. Should a lawsuit be filed against the City alleging injury, property damage or loss – the assigned Deputy City Attorney shall file a Petition of Disclosure of Juvenile Records with the Presiding Judge of the Unified Family Court.
