I further agree that I will not attempt to subpoena or otherwise seek to involuntarily compel the call taker, or any representative of the Legal Ethics Committee or of The Bar Association of San Francisco to testify in connection with my inquiry, nor will I permit anyone to do so on my behalf.
6. Information provided by the call taker is not binding on any court, The State Bar of California, The Bar Association of San Francisco, or any member of the State Bar of California.
7. I understand that except as provided herein, the call taker will endeavor to keep my identity confidential. However, the subject matter of my inquiry may be brought to the attention of the Legal Ethics Committee for appropriate Committee action, including but not limited to creating a Formal Opinion of the Committee or recommending modifications to applicable rules. I further understand that the call taker, the Committee Chair, or another Committee member may contact me with further comments if the Committee believes it appropriate to do so.
