

BASF Sends Letter of Support for AB 251

March 25, 2013 – San Francisco – The Bar Association of San Francisco recently sent a letter to the Honorable Bob Wieckowski, Chair of the Assembly Judiciary Committee at the State Capitol, in support of AB 251.

AB 251, as amended, would permit family law courts to utilize electronic reporting for purposes of creating an official record of court proceedings. The bill permits the use of electronic reporting in family law cases, only when an official court reporter is not available.
