



Frequently Asked Questions For Employers

Who can participate in the Bay Area Diversity Career Fair (BADCF)?

Any law firm, corporate in-house legal department, government agency, nonprofit or other private/public legal employer is welcome to participate.

Is BADCF virtual or in-person?

BADCF will once again be virtual this year.

How do I register?

Visit the BADCF site at <https://www.sfbar.org/jdc/diversity/career-fair/> to create an account (or log in to an existing account), select the number of schedules you are interested in, and pay the registration fee. Once you have paid, Orrick will approve your Symplicity registration.

What do I do after I've paid for my registration?

Please visit Orrick's website at <https://basf-orrick-dcf-csm.symplicity.com/> to create an account or log into an existing account.

When will I be notified that my registration has been accepted?

Once your registration has been approved by Orrick, you will receive a confirmation email from Symplicity.

Is the BADCF preselect or lottery-based?

Employers preselect 75% of their interview schedule(s). The remaining slots, or 25% of the schedule, is randomly assigned via a lottery system.

When will I receive my final schedule?

You will receive an email with your final interview schedule no sooner than three days before the career fair.
